

CUSTOM ENGRAVING

Imbue a gift with meaning all your own by inscribing with a personalized message, or custom engraving of a monogram, family crest, school seal, picture or signature. We can add engraving to most designs – making it an ideal way to honor a milestone.

HOW DOES ENGRAVING WORK?

Once the digital mockup of an engraved design is approved, the text or artwork is made into a stencil. The stencil is then affixed onto the glass and sandblasted with very fine grit sand for a neat, uniform application that allows for tonal ranges and a variety of fonts.

ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

- High-resolution (300 dpi) EPS, PDF, or TIFF black/white digital files. We cannot accept JPEG files, images downloaded from websites as JPEG files or images that are less than 300 dpi.
- We accept files created in Adobe Illustrator, InDesign, or Photoshop, formatted for a Mac. We cannot accept Microsoft Word, PageMaker, Paintbrush, CorelDRAW or PowerPoint files.
- Hard copies (not faxes) of artwork – such as logos on business cards, photos, invitations and printed text – are acceptable.
- For monograms or initials, please indicate the letter-order preference and font.


THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Simon Pearce handblown glass is unique and may contain small bubbles.
- The pontil trademark is found on the bottom of each piece.
- Engraved items are non-returnable.



PRODUCT CARE

GLASS

Simon Pearce glass is created by master glassblowers using the finest materials and artisan techniques. Hand washing is recommended, although dishwasher safe. Do not expose to extreme temperature changes. A shock in temperatures from hot or cold liquids can cause fractures. Glass is not recommended for use in microwaves or ovens. Do not place glass objects in direct sunlight as certain angles magnify light, causing a potential fire hazard. Glass is lead-free.

CANDLEHOLDERS

Due to the handmade nature of our candleholders, shapes and sizes may vary. Extinguish tapers and pillar candles when flame reaches two inches above the base. Never leave burning candles unattended.

POTTERY

Our pottery is lead-free, handcrafted stoneware. It is dishwasher, microwave, freezer and oven safe. If placed in the freezer, bring to room temperature before placing in the microwave or oven.

Do not expose pottery to extreme temperature changes; this can cause fractures.

FLATWARE

All flatware is made of the finest quality stainless steel.

While dishwasher safe, avoid cleaners that may contain citrus. To prevent spotting, heat or hand dry immediately. Please note that dry spots are easily removed by rubbing with a damp soft cloth.

Over time a natural patina is possible. If oxidation occurs, light buffing is recommended.
